MUST-HAVES

- 1. Wet Bags (2): One large for storing soiled diapers, one small for use in public toilets. You can repurpose a zippered plastic bag
- 2. Extra Diapers:
- Flats: Ideal for longer stays as they wash and dry quickly.
- Pocket Diapers: Pre-stuffed with liners or flats for easy changes ,cleanup and quicker drying
- Disposable or reusable liners: For easier poop cleanups.
- 3. Washing Supplies for longer stay(cations):
- A small amount of your preferred detergent.
- A brush or plunger for manual washing (optional).

NICE-TO-HAVES

- 1. Changing mat
- 2. Wool covers (require less frequent washing)
- 3. Portable potty (for EC families): If you are practicing EC it will reduce number of cloth diapers you have to handle or wash.
- 4. Portable jet spray or sauce bottle
 (especially helpful in paper-only toilets abroad)
- 5. Diaper liners
- 6. Rope or clothesline for drying
